Throughout the summer the CCNS Board of Officers and Trustees, along with the Administration, have diligently reviewed the ever evolving guidelines and protocols established by the CDC, the state and county Departments of Health, and all other governing bodies. We have discussed what the numerous requirements and recommendations would look like at CCNS and how we would be able to continue our educational mission to learn through play.
