Crossing Cooperative Nursery School is pleased to announce Registration for our 2026-2027 “Wee Play & Learn” Program

“Wee Play & Learn” is an exclusive CCNS program for children who will be 2 years on or before February 1, 2027. Alongside a parent (or other caregiver), children will have the opportunity to participate in an array of preschool experiences including center time, dramatic play, art exploration, STEM experiences, creative movement, circle time, outdoor play (weather permitting), and story time. It's a wonderful opportunity to share the fun and excitement of your child's first school experience.

Under the direction of an experienced teacher, a child & their caregiver will enjoy a weekly theme designed to support the activities that day. In addition, children will enjoy participating in broader themes celebrated throughout CCNS such as holiday events, "We Love to Read" month, Good Health and Nutrition, Fire Safety Week, and more. This nurturing, loving environment is conducive to making special new friends, and is a great way to get to know our school, teachers and programs. The Wee Play and Learn class is also a wonderful introduction to a child's first school experience.

Classes will meet either on **Tuesday mornings from 9:00-10:30am, Wednesday mornings from 9:00-10:30am or Friday mornings from 9:00-10:30**. The program runs from September through May, and is limited to 8 children per class. The tuition for this class is **\$900.00** per year and may be paid bi-annually. Due to the participatory nature of our program, please note that younger or older siblings are not permitted to attend.

Children in this program do not have to be toilet trained. All participants (registered prior to December 31st of 2026) will receive **priority in January 2027** over alumni families and new families in registering for our regular classes the following school year.
