- Families seeking a gentle, play-based transition
- Children attending morning Kindergarten who would benefit from afternoon enrichment
- Families interested in a hybrid homeschool enrichment option

Rooted in child-centered, play-based learning, CCNS Transitional Kindergarten supports children’s social, emotional, and academic development in a joyful, hands-on environment. Children build confidence, independence, early academic foundations, and a lifelong love of learning — all while honoring where they are developmentally.
